Dear Mr. Broadway:

Enclosed is the Harrison County Wastewater Management District Industrial/Commercial Sewage Disposal Permit Application Form. This form is a way to provide advance notification to the POTW that treated groundwater will be discharged from a remediation system to the base sewer system which discharges to the City of Gulfport sewer system and ultimately treated at the Harrison County POTW. The groundwater treatment system will be located at Site 6, a former fire-fighting training area, at Naval Construction Battalion Center (NCBC) in Gulfport, Mississippi.

NCBC is part of the Installation Restoration (IR) program which has been initiated by the Department of Defense. The IR program complies with the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) as amended by the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA). According to CERCLA 42 USC9621(e), "No Federal, State or local permit shall be required for the portion of any removal or remedial action conducted entirely onsite, where such remedial action is selected and carried out in compliance with this section."

An interim action remediation system is scheduled to begin operating in June, 1995. The objective of the system is to recover free-phase product which is floating on the water table. Groundwater that is extracted with the free-phase product will be separated in the oil and water separator and then treated in the air stripper prior to being discharged to the base sewer system.
