
Dear Mr. Bradley:

In reference to your letter of January 23, 1989, and in conjunction with the recent draft HSWA permit for your Boca Chica facility, enclosed please find a copy of the final Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Facility Assessment (RFA).

Due to the supplemental interim data provided to the Environmental Protection Agency on January 23, 1989, some changes were made in the RFA regarding units needing further action. The most significant change is that the waste water treatment plant does not need further investigation under a RCRA Facility Investigation (RFI). However, the Bead Blasting Area must remain on the RFI list due to the reasons outlined in the RFA. Also, there were some errors in the draft RFA that have been corrected.
