The Underground Storage Tank (UST) Removals at the Harry S. Truman Animal Import Center (HSTAIC), Fleming Key, Florida, are complete except for the contaminated soil disposal. The 8,000 gallon UST site is completely closed and the Closure Assessment Report is forwarded herein. The two (2) 4,000 gallon UST site was contaminated and its Closure Assessment Report will be forwarded when the contaminated soil is disposed.

The local Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) office has been notified regarding both sites. The FDEP will require a Site Assessment Report (SAR) for the two (2) 4,000 gallon UST site. The SAR will be required to be submitted within 120 days of the removal in accordance with 62-770 (FAC).
