



Dear Mr. Patrick:

I have completed the review of the above referenced document dated June 1999 (received July 6, 1999). Based upon extensive NAS Key West team discussions regarding the soil investigation and the fact that there is no confirmed soil contamination, the report is adequate for its purpose. As discussed, the Finding Of Suitability to Transfer (FOST) for this subparcel must include language describing the U.S. Navy's responsibility in monitoring groundwater for arsenic as well specific covenant language limiting groundwater use. Please note, before the transfer process can proceed, the FOST and the deed conveyance document will have to be approved by the FDEP.
