


Dear Mr. Demes:

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection concurs with the Decision Document (DD) for IR-21, Seminole Battery at Naval Air Station Key West. The DD specifies institutional controls prohibiting excavation next to the foundations and disturbance of the soil cap as the selected remedial alternative. Specific land-use institutional controls applicable to IR-21 shall be part of the NAS Key West Land Use Control Memorandum of Agreement.

The alternative referenced above has been selected as a cost effective remedy that provides protection of public health and the environment. The selected remedial alternative will be implemented in accordance with the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) as amended by the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA) and the National Contingency Plan (40 CFR 300). Accordingly, the above site shall undergo a five-year review with the costs of the review to be absorbed by the federal government.
