I have reviewed both first and second quarters of the AS/SVE system for Building 189. Both versions of the reports are adequate for its intent as well as their recommendations. As discussed, continue monitoring, for the amount of time called for in State regulations, to ascertain the lack of rebound in contaminant concentration post-system shutoff. Upon finalization of the groundwater monitoring period, a comprehensive report detailing actions taken, goals reached, graphs and tables will be expected before an unrestricted No Further Action is granted.
