Dear Jorge Caspary:

Naval Air Station Key West has received the remedial action plan (RAP) for our flying club site prepared by ABB Environmental. This plan is due to you mid-July. There are concerns about the cost and magnitude of the proposed remediation relative to the small size, low level of contamination, and low risk level. We would also like to investigate the feasibility of bioremediation of that site as an option.

As discussed between you and Gabriel Magwood of Southern Division Naval Facility Engineering Command on 19 July 1994, we are requesting a 120 day time extension for submission of the flying club RAP. This would give us time to perform a pilot bioremediation study to determine feasibility of using this technology here in the Keys' unique geology.
