Dear Sir:

These comments are provided in response to information provided
in the above referenced documentation January 2, 1986.

1. Information on the geology and hydrology of the sites on the base appear to be satisfactory in terms of locating and providing monitoring wells.
2. The list of analytical parameters selected for measurement in groundwater samples should be expanded to include the one hundred and twenty-three (123) priority pollutants.
3. A plan to provide better communication and coordination with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Regional Office in these studies needs to be considered in anticipation that inactive sites will be regulated by provisions of the 1984 amendments to the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA).
4. Sites selected for confirmation studies need to include any that were used for fire training (usually associated with the operation of military aircraft).
