In accordance with requirements under the U.S. Department of Defense Munitions Response Program (MRP) the U.S. Department of the Navy (Navy) has identified four munitions response sites (MRSs) at Naval Air Station (NAS) Key West, Florida. These sites have been designated as:

- UXO 01: Fleming Key Drudge Spoil Area
- UXO 02: Near Shore Underwater Ranges
- UXO 03: Trumbo Point Temporary Staging Area
- UXO 04: Taxiway D Drainage Ditch

The MRP requires that the Navy utilize a prescribed Munitions Response Site Prioritization Protocol (MRSP) to assign relative risk and prioritization for future MRS-related response activities. MRSP evaluations have been prepared for these MRSs based upon the results of available site investigations. These site investigation records are available to the general public in accordance with the requirements of Title 32, Code of Federal Regulation, Part 179. The Navy is seeking public and stakeholder review and comment on these evaluations with regard to

safety and environmental concerns.

precisely the action petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the proposed action.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that FDEP's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the FDEP have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Any person may request a public meeting regarding the proposed permitting decision pursuant to Section 03.722(10), F.S. A request for a public meeting is not equivalent to a request for a formal or informal administrative hearing. Public meetings are not evidentiary in nature, and information submitted at a public meeting is for non-binding consideration only. A public meeting is not subject to court or appellate review.
