We have reviewed your revised RCRA Facility Investigation Workplan, dated December 1989, which you submitted as required by condition II.C.2 of your permit [effective date 3/25/88]. Our review concludes that your submittal does not completely satisfy the condition. Enclosed with this letter are comments describing the technical inadequacies and informing you of the necessary changes or additions.

Please send your revised RCRA Facility Investigation Workplan within sixty (60) days of receipt of this letter. Note that until this item is approved, you have not fulfilled the permit requirements. Continued noncompliance may result in sanctions pursuant to §3008 of RCRA, 42 U.S.C. 6928, consistent with Executive Order 12088, Federal Compliance with Pollution Control Standards.
