The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), has received and reviewed the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Facility Investigation (RFI) Work Plan, Supplemental Sampling (SWMUs) at Naval Station Mayport. Based upon the review, EPA approves this document pursuant condition II.E.1.d. of your Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) permit effective June 15, 1993. Enclosed are general comments agreed to during our last management meeting to be incorporated into the workplans. EPA will accept errata sheets to be substituted for pages requiring revision. Please include an index with the errata sheets which pages are to be substituted. These errata pages are due to EPA by February 2, 1995.


In accordance with permit condition II.E.1.d. and the approved CAMP, the Draft RFI and Confirmatory Sampling Reports must be submitted to this office no later than November 13, 1995.

Failure to comply with any permit condition may result in sanctions pursuant to Section §3008(a) of the RCRA, 42 U.S.C. 6928, as amended by the Federal Facility Compliance Act of 1992, under which EPA may seek the imposition of penalties of up to \$25,000 for each day of continued non-compliance.

RFI WORKPLAN COMMENTS:

- o NAVSTA to issue letter to FTC directing best management practices by defining specific actions (detention pond, stormwater management, overflow to storm drain, to prevent overflow to environment) as well as appropriate management controls to ensure additional releases do not occur prior to moving to new FTC facility in 1996.
- o 3-7, figure for SWMU 24 & 25, needs indicate location of waste containment at corner of building.
- o 3-23, geophysical survey grid, perform additional passes through recreation area (change to the figure)
- o General: Take biased surface soils samples in worst looking areas.
- o Remove statements related to the collection of unfiltered ground and surface water data.
- o Clarify workplan target analities noted on pages 3-31, 3-43, 3-47, 4-1 and state that TICs will be requested in order to capture items on TAL/TCL that are not included in Appendix IX. Ensure all tables are consistent with revisions.

RFA WORKPLAN COMMENTS:

- o p 3-5, waste oil storage area SWMU 20, take surface soil sample at drain (bias sample locations to worst case scenarios)
