Naval Station Mayport (NAVSTA) is scheduled to begin removal of approximately 260 cubic yards of PCB contaminated soil from Solid Waste Management Unit 2 (SWMU) on July 24, 1995. NAVSTA has contracted through Southern Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, for removal of these soils to be performed by Bechtel Environmental. The removal at this SWMU is being performed in accordance with provisions of our HSWA Permit #FL9 170 024 260 and has been approved by the USEPA Region IV and Florida Department of Environmental Protection Tallahassee.

The soils will be transported and disposed of in accordance with 40 CFR 761. Final disposal will be at a landfill operated by Chemical Waste Management, Inc. at Mile Marker 163, Highway 17, Emelle, Alabama.
