
The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), has received and reviewed the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Facility Investigation Report (RFI) for the Group 1 Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) dated March 1996 for Naval Station Mayport. Based upon the review, EPA approves this document pursuant to condition II.E.3.c of your Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) permit effective June 15, 1993.

No further investigation or corrective measures studies are recommended for SWMUs 2, 3, 4, 5, 22 and 13. These recommendations are based on the land use of these SWMUs remaining industrial; if the land use scenario changes in the future, these recommendations must be reevaluated. It is recommended that the ditch bisecting SWMU 4 be filled as an Interim Measure to reduce the exposure of ecological receptors to potentially harmful sediments. Additional ecological sampling may be required after the completion of the IM to assess the need for additional remedial measures.

Draft IM Reports must be submitted to this office in accordance with the compliance schedule delineated in Mayport's approved Corrective Action Management Plan (CAMP).
