EPA has reviewed the following Technical Memorandum letter:

- **Groundwater Sample Results - SWMU 19 - NAVSTA Mayport,**
HLA, October 14, 1998.

EPA considers this document adequate for its purpose and approves it as final. The sampling event reported in this Technical Memorandum was undertaken to supplement the assessment activities previously reported in the **RFA for SWMU Groups I and II** (ABB-ES, 1995a). Based on the sum total of information presented in these reports, EPA concurs with the recommendation for No Further Action. This recommendation is based on the inclusion of SWMU 19 in the NAVSTA Mayport MOA for Land Use Controls (LUCs). The LUCs for SWMU 19 should prevent both the development of SWMU 19 as a residential area and the use of the groundwater.
