Dear Ms. Washington:

I have reviewed the above document dated November 1999 (received December 27, 1999). I have also reviewed the previous quarterly report dated August 1999 in conjunction with the Annual report. The report recommends that only EPA Method 602 + MTBE analyses be conducted in the future because of the low levels of PAHs being noted in the ground water analyses. Considering that the pipeline break was for diesel fuel and the fact that free product has been found at the site, please continue to conduct analyses for both volatile and semivolatile petroleum constituents plus MTBE. After the next quarterly sample, we will review the analytical requirements. In the interim, please continue to monitor and remove the free product and continue to sample the monitoring wells on a quarterly basis.
