I have reviewed the above document dated August 2002 (received August 9, 2002). The document has adequately addressed my previous concerns. The document recommends the following actions for the individual SWMUs:

SWMU 14 – Mercury/Oil Waste Spill Area. The selected alternatives are:

1. Soil/sediment - capping, land use controls and site monitoring.
2. Groundwater – passive skimming with monitoring; following source removal, MNA will be instituted with land use controls.

SWMU 15 – Old Pesticide Handling Area. The selected alternatives are:

1. Soil/sediment - capping, land use controls and site monitoring.
2. Groundwater – MNA, land use controls and site monitoring.

The selected alternatives are a good balance of practicability and cost and incorporate a reasonable time frame for the current/future use of the sites. I concur with the conclusions of the document.
