



The document notes that this site was formerly under a monitoring program but that a new petroleum spill in April 2000 necessitated this new SAR. Free product and contaminated soil are present, along with minimal groundwater contamination. The SAR fulfills the requirements of Chapter 62-770.600, F.A.C. Please prepare a Remedial Action Plan that addresses the free product, contaminated soil and groundwater, as appropriate, at the site.
