

I have reviewed the above document dated August 11, 2006 (received August 17, 2006). The document describes the proposed soil and groundwater-monitoring program for the sites. The only comment I have is of an "information only" nature: groundwater sampling in the past showed great variation with respect to the presence of free product based on antecedent rain events and site groundwater levels. The contractor should keep this in mind. The present document is acceptable.
