I have completed my review of the subject document which was dated March 2009 and was received on March 16, 2009. This document presents the findings of the confirmatory sampling activities completed at Area of Concern (AOC) E. The primary objective of the confirmatory sampling (CS) was to provide data to evaluate the current environmental conditions and to determine the presence or absence of contamination at the site. The CS activities were guided by the CS Work Plan (TtNUS, 2007) which was approved by NAVFAC SE. In order to achieve this primary objective, soil and groundwater samples were collected and analyzed. Based on the results of the confirmatory samples, a RCRA Facilities Investigation (RFI) has been recommended to completely characterize and delineate the horizontal and vertical extent of contaminants in the soil at AOC E. FDEP concurs with this recommendation.
