**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING ON PROPOSED ENVIRONMENTAL CLEANUP AT THE NAVAL TRAINING CENTER (NTC), ORLANDO**  
An Interim Remedial Action (IRA) is planned for the former Base Laundry and adjacent areas at NTC Orlando. This area has been designated as Operable Unit (OU) 4 in the ongoing Installation Restoration environmental pro-

gram at NTC. The IRA is an early cleanup action to address groundwater and sediment contamination at OU 4. Two cleanup methods are proposed for the IRA:  
**in-well stripping (for groundwater):** groundwater is pumped into wells where contaminants are turned into gas and then treated (or stripped). The treated gas is released into the air once it meets applicable environmental standards, and the groundwater is returned.  
**natural attenuation (for sediment):** sediment is left undisturbed and contaminants are allowed to breakdown and disperse naturally. Long-term monitoring of the sediment will also be required to ensure that contaminants are breaking down as expected.  
A community meeting to discuss the proposed OU 4 IRA cleanup alternative will be held on March 20, 1997 at 8:30 p.m. at the Winter Park City Hall Commission Chambers, 401 Park Avenue South (second floor). Cleanup specialists will provide a briefing on the proposed cleanup, followed by a public comment and question period. The meeting will be preceded by the regular session of the NTC Orlando Restoration Advisory Board (RAB).  
A public comment period on the OU 4 IRA will also be held from February 27, 1997 to March 28, 1997. Comments are encouraged and should be directed to Mr. Wayne Hansel at 407-646-5294 or by mail to:
