I have completed my review of the Project Update Report, Groundwater Investigation Study, Study Area 39, Naval Training Center, Orlando, dated February 18, 2000 (received February 21, 2000), prepared and submitted by the Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The interim report is suitable for its intent. I concur with Tetra Tech's recommendation to install a shallow, intermediate and deep monitoring well cluster 175 feet due east of well cluster 04A, 15B and 16C. I also concur that it is not necessary at this time to delineate the contaminants chloroform and bromodichloromethane in groundwater. These contaminants were not detected in the previous investigation and are most often associated with water treatment. However, if subsequent sampling and analysis of groundwater verifies these contaminants, further investigation may be required.
