

I have completed the review of the Source Removal Report (SRR) for Building 128, Main Base, Naval Training Center, Orlando, dated September 2000 (received September 18, 2000), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. Based upon my review, I concur with the consultant's conclusion that all petroleum impacted soil exceeding FDEP Soil Cleanup Target Levels has been removed. I also concur with the recommendation of installing and sampling a permanent monitoring well for the Gasoline and Kerosene Analytical Groups prior to preparation and submittal of a Site Assessment Report for this site.
