
I have completed my review of the Draft Final Specification for Site Monitoring for Operable Unit 3, Orlando Naval Training Center, dated November 2000 (received November 16, 2000), prepared and submitted by Harding Lawson Associates. The overall concept for implementing the groundwater monitoring plan, the institutional controls and site reviews is acceptable. However, I have the following comments that should be addressed in the final report:

- (1) On page 1-1, first bullet, change chemicals of potential concern (COPCs) to chemicals of concern (COCs).
- (2) Page 1-16, Section 1.3.1.2, first bullet, change "primary and secondary standards" to "groundwater cleanup target levels."
- (3) Page 2-7, third bullet, same as comment (2).
- (4) There is some confusion in the report concerning describing Florida groundwater cleanup target levels as State MCLs. It is apparent from Table 1-2, that what are termed State MCLs in the report are actually the Department's groundwater cleanup target levels as listed in Chapter 62-777, Florida Administrative Code. However, the term MCL is most often used to denote a federal primary drinking water standard.
