

I have completed my review of the Final Site Investigation Report, Study Area 55, Orlando Naval Training Center, dated June 2004 (received June 16, 2004), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The report is adequate for its intent and is approved as final. The excavation of approximately 372 tons of soil contaminated with polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbons with concentrations greater than three times the residential soil cleanup target level for benzo(a)pyrene equivalents has remediated the site to be protective for unrestricted reuse of the site.
