

Dear Mrs. Nwokike:

I have completed my review of the Draft Final Proposed Plan for Operable Unit 2, McCoy Annex, Orlando Naval Training Center, dated August 2005 (received August 23, 2005), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. I have the following comments on the document:

- (1) The EPA ID number (FL6170023711) should be in the Facility Description portion of the Site History section.
- (2) On page 5, Remedial Action Objectives Section, Groundwater, RAO 1, is the first place GCTLs is used. The first time GCTLs is used in the document, it should be spelled out and GCTLs place in paratheses immediately after it.
- (3) On page 6, Alternative N-2, it says that "The goal for placing additional soil is to have at least 1.5 feet of native soil cover over the entire landfill area." The goal should be to have at least 2 feet of native soil cover over the entire landfill area. This, and not the proposed 1.5 feet of cover, would be consistent with previous decisions concerning landfill cover thickness at Operable Unit 1, Operable Unit 2 (southern portion) and Study Area 2 (landfill areas).
- (4) On page 9, Proposed Plan section, second paragraph, same as comment (3).


