

I have completed my review of the Data Evaluation Report for Operable Unit 2, Naval Training Center Orlando, dated September 2005 (received October 7, 2005), prepared and submitted by Tetra Tech NUS, Inc. The report is suitable for its intent and is approved. I concur that groundwater monitoring of the three groundwater contaminant plumes may proceed on a semi-annual basis with those wells specified in Table 6-1. However, as Operable Unit 2 is a landfill site and there is continuing evidence of contaminants leaching out of buried wastes, a schedule needs to be developed for sampling and analyzing those wells not being used to monitor the three plumes in order to determine if other contaminant plumes may develop that need monitoring.
