There were two key agenda items for the December meeting: (1) completion of the RAB Charter and (2) selection of the Community Co-Chair and an alternate. Lt. Commander Ballinger, the Navy Co-Chair, opened the meeting and turned it over to Todd Sorrow to discuss the RAB Charter.

RAB Charter

Development of a RAB charter was completed by discussing each item presented in a draft charter (as prepared by a subcommittee comprised of Di Silkwood, Mark Solomon, and Todd Sorrow). A copy of the final charter will be presented to the RAB at the January meeting for signature.

Selection of Community Co-Chair

The process for selecting the community co-chair began with taking volunteers and/or nominations for the position. Each volunteer was then asked to summarize (verbally) their qualifications and interest in the role of community co-chair of the RAB. Following the presentations, a hidden ballot was taken for the co-chair position and tallied by Lt. Commander Ballinger. Todd Sorrow was selected as the Community Co-Chair. A second ballot was then taken for the alternate community co-chair. Anna

Currie was selected as the Alternate Community Co-Chair.

January RAB Meeting

The January RAB meeting will be held on January 12, 1994. The RAB decided that this meeting will be opened to the public. Agenda topics include signing of the RAB charter as well as an update on the tanks and IR Program. The public will be asked to hold all comments until the end of the meeting. Blank cards will be passes out to the public to write down questions. Questions will be collected from the crowd throughout the meeting. The meeting will be held at either the Audubon Park Elementary School or the Glen Ridge Elementary School, if either are available.

Other Business

Nancy Rouse of ABB asked for a volunteer to assist in the development of a fact sheet. The fact sheet is being prepared to address the **perception** that there may be health risks in the neighborhood that are being associated with NTC, Orlando. Di Silkwood volunteered to help with the fact sheet.
