



Dear Mr. Ugolini:

I have completed the technical review of the IRA Notification Form dated July 17, 1996 (received July 26, 1996) submitted for Building 7174. The form indicates that a vacuum enhanced system is being used to extract free product. Chapter 62-770.300(2), F.A.C. states "free product recovery which requires dewatering or groundwater extraction which causes groundwater table depression is prohibited unless approved by the Department as an alternative procedure pursuant to Rule 62-770.890, F.A.C." Either change your method of free product recovery to eliminate depression of the groundwater table, or submit in writing a request, along with supportive information, for an alternative procedure order.
