

Dear Mr. Ugolini:

I have completed the technical review of the Site Assessment Report (SAR) Addendum dated September 5, 1997 (received September 5, 1997) submitted for Building 2273. I do not agree with overdevelopment of the monitoring wells MW-1, DW-1 and DW-2. There appears to be a downward gradient as deep monitoring well DW-1 has higher levels of contamination than the shallow wells. I recommend installing another monitoring well adjacent to DW-2 and downgradient of well DW-1; screened at a depth of 40 - 45 feet. Sampling and analysis should be performed in wells MW-1, MW-2, MW-4, DW-1, DW-2 and the newly installed well. Please submit a SAR Addendum according to revised Chapter 62-770 F.A.C.
