I have completed my review of the March 2013 Semi-Annual Monitoring Report, Operable Unit 3 - Study Areas 8 and 9, Former Naval Training Center Orlando, dated June 2013 (received August 30, 2013), prepared and submitted by Barnes, Ferland and Associates, Inc. The report is suitable for its intent. Please note that some of the water level measurements appeared anomalous and did not conform to the water level contours depicted in Figures 4 and 5. However, the fact that many of the monitoring wells were of different well diameters, installed at different depths or installed within, immediately before or immediately after the permeable adsorptive barrier walls may explain some of the anomalous water level measurements.
