Gentlemen:

As part of our on-going efforts to protect and preserve the environment, following the guidelines of the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA), a Technical Review Committee (TRC) meeting is scheduled for May 10, 1994. The meeting will be held at 9:00 a.m. in the Supply Department Conference Room, Building 1205, U.S. Naval Station, Roosevelt Roads. As a member of the committee, you are invited to attend.

The purpose of the meeting is to review and comment on proposed and ongoing site remedial actions. This committee includes representatives from Federal and Commonwealth of Puerto Rico regulatory agencies, along with local government and community representatives.

Since our last TRC meeting on July 15, 1992, further studies have been performed at various sites and remedial action taken. At the TRC meeting scheduled for May 10, we will discuss the remedial actions taken at three of the sites, results from the most recent field effort, the proposed scope of field work under Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Corrective Action, and the environmental statute change in Naval Station's IR Program from Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) to RCRA Corrective Action.

The sites undergoing interim remedial action are Sites 15, 16 and 21. Site 15 covers Substation Number 2, Site 16 includes the old power plant at Building 38, and Site 21 is an old pesticide storage facility located at Building 121. Copies of the decision documents for Sites 15 and 16 remedial action and a copy of the closure plan for Site 21 are included for your information. Also enclosed are the agenda for the TRC meeting and the TRC member list.

Additionally, our contractor, Baker Environmental, Inc., will be forwarding a copy of the supplemental investigation reporting the most recent field effort, and the proposed future field work under RCRA corrective action for your review.

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Your participation in this meeting is encouraged. Please forward your written comments to the address shown above, Attention: N02C-B13, by April 22, 1994 so they can be properly addressed at the meeting.
