**THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY  
ANNOUNCES THE AVAILABILITY OF THE RECORDS  
OF DECISION FOR THE CLEAN-UP (INTERIM  
REMEDIAL ACTION) OF POLYCHLORINATED  
BIPHENYL (PCB)-CONTAMINATED SOILS ADJACENT TO  
BUILDINGS 90 AND 38 (SITES 15 AND 16)  
U.S. NAVAL STATION ROOSEVELT ROADS**

On February 1, 1994, U.S. Naval Station, Roosevelt Roads, signed Records of Decision (RODs) that formally select the clean-up plan for the soil contamination adjacent to Buildings 90 and 38. The ROD outlines the Navy's decisions for selecting the clean-up remedies for the sites. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) concurs with the remediation recommendations contained in the ROD.

The Navy has decided to excavate the contaminated soils, transport them to an approved facility (U.S. Ecology, Beatty, Nevada) for disposal of Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs).

The Administrative Record for the sites, which includes the RODs and all documents that formed the basis for the Navy's selection of the clean-up remedy, is available for public review at the locations listed below.
