This is in response to your letter to Captain Richmond of January 24, 1983, concerning alleged violations of the California Hazardous Waste Control Act, California Hazardous Waste Control Regulations and our Interim Status Document.

Operations at the Naval Air Station, Alameda involve no storage of hazardous wastes for periods greater than 60 days. Therefore, in accordance with the recommendations of your staff, we have initiated action to cancel our permit application for a hazardous waste storage facility. An official copy of the letter requesting cancellation has been provided your agency.
