APPROPRIATE" REQUIREMENTS (ARARS) FOR REMOVAL ACTIONS AT
ALAMEDA POINT, ALAMEDA, CALIFORNIA

Thank you for your letter of October 2, 2001, in which you requested direction to documentation on IR Sites 14 and 15. Recently, the Navy and the BCT decided to cancel a removal action that was planned for Site 15 due to recent findings that suggested only a very minor amount of contamination exists at the site. Therefore, ARARs for that site are not required at this time. The following documents should help you with background information for Site 14.

1. Draft OU-2 Remedial Investigation Report, Volume V, Chapter 9, for Alameda Point, of June 23, 1999.
2. Draft Installation Restoration Site 14, Dioxin Non-Time Critical Removal Action, Action Memorandum, for Alameda Point of August 24, 2001.
