**REQUEST FOR APPLICABLE, RELEVANT AND APPROPRIATE REQUIREMENTS
(ARARS)**

The Alameda Naval Air Station (ANAS), Alameda County is currently undergoing Remedial Investigation as required by CERCLA (Superfund) and Chapter 6.8 of the Health and Safety Code. Under these laws, the U.S. Navy will investigate and subsequently remediate ANAS in accordance with all Applicable, Relevant and Appropriate Requirements (ARARs). As part of this procedure, we are requesting that you provide your agency specific ARARs. Through this process, the State will be able to ensure that your requirements and concerns are addressed and satisfied during the remediation of ANAS.

The ARARs for this site may include environmental and public health laws and regulations promulgated by your agency. We request that your agency provide to the Department either copies of, or reference to, all regulations and laws applicable to this site which are within your jurisdiction.

Please provide the above information no later than November 9, 1992. Identification of ARARs is essential to the timely and cost effective achievement of remedial goals at this site. Your cooperation would be greatly appreciated. All correspondence should be sent to:

The U.S. Navy acquired the site from the U.S. Army in 1936 and subsequently constructed an Air Station. Several sites that supported the air station operations in the past are currently under remedial investigations and are as follows: Metal plating and paint stripping, aircraft maintenance, fueling and engine testing, vehicle service stations, pest control, missile reworking, operation of a power plant, and fire response training areas. Other sites also existed such as: Two landfills, a lagoon, an estuary and wetlands which may have received hazardous materials in the past. The two landfills may also have received low-level radioactive materials and operated between 1943 and 1956, and between 1958 and 1978.
