Dear Ms. Lasky:

This letter is in response to your letter of 27 August 1992 regarding the Removal Action for low pH and elevated levels of lead in soil around Boring B-7 at the Intermediate Maintenance Facility (IMF) site at NAS Alameda.

The Navy is currently undertaking contractual actions with our CLEAN consultant, PRC to conduct an Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) and Plan of Action and Milestones (POAM).

We are planning to award this contract to PRC by mid November 1992. Our schedule is to submit a draft final POAM for your review in mid January 1993 and a draft final EE/CA for your review in mid February 1993.

As requested in your letter, Health and Safety procedures will be addressed in the EE/CA report for contaminants encountered during the Removal Action. Also as requested, a contingency plan for field responses to floating product that may be encountered during the Removal Action will be addressed as part of the EE/CA report.
