**RADIATION SURVEY AND FIELD SAMPLING WORK PLAN, AND DATA  
TRANSMITTAL MEMORANDUM, SITES 1 & 2 RADIATION SURVEY  
REPORT, NAVAL AIR STATION, ALAMEDA**

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) and the California Department of Health Services (DHS) have reviewed the above mentioned documents. We find the Data Transmittal Memorandum, Sites 1 & 2 Radiation Survey Report to be adequate. The field work described in the Radiation Survey and Field Sampling Work Plan is already in progress. We have not found any reason to adjust the ongoing field work. We will review the resulting survey and field sampling reports and may raise questions or request further evaluation after reviewing those reports. 


