Subject: Discharge of Treated Water from Excavation Trenches, Alameda Naval Air Station, Alameda County

Dear Mr. Murphy:

Alameda Naval Air Station, formerly known as Alameda Point, is discharging treated water from its excavation trenches during the radiological removal action at Buildings 5 and 10. Staff at the Regional Water Quality Control Board (Board) issued requirements for this discharge in a letter dated June 9, 1998 (see attached). The requirements were based on a modification of the Board's general NPDES permit for discharge of treated groundwater resulting from the cleanup of groundwater polluted by volatile organic compounds.

At the time of the letter, it was thought that the project would be complete by December 1998. However, funding problems at the base have prevented its completion, and Alameda Naval Air Station has requested additional time to finish discharging from the trenches to Seaplane Lagoon. I hereby extend the discharge period provided that the following conditions are satisfied:

- These are site specific requirements only for the discharge of water from excavation pits created during the radiological removal action at Buildings 5 and 10;
- This is a short-term discharge, scheduled to end by September 1, 1999;
- Volume of discharge is limited to 1.5 million gallons;
- Discharge is on-site into Seaplane Lagoon, a salt-water receiving water body;
- Radiological discharge requirements will be provided by USEPA and California Department of Health;
- Discharge shall comply with attached Substantive Requirements
