The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) reviewed the subject Time Critical Removal Action (TCRA) Memorandum. The objective of the TCRA is to prevent potential exposure to children at a day care center and adjacent elementary school from PAH contaminated soil in play areas. The Navy will excavate the soil in the affected areas, and backfill with woodchips under play structures, concrete in some areas and artificial turf in the remaining areas. EPA concurs with the need for this action.
