Hi Lou:

I am out of the office on vaction and do not have access to my documents.
So, here is the two possible answers to your question.

One, if AST 021B is not under the jurisdiction of the Water Board, what you are proposing is ok.

Two, if AST 021B is under the jurisdiction of the Petroleum program, I would suggest you revise the language.

Water Board staff has not closed AST 021B.

Therefore, it will not be correct to state in the ROD that "no further action is required for AST 021B."

If number two is true, you might want to revise the ROD to state that Navy has requested no further action to be conducted for AST 021B and that Water Board staff will address the closure of AST 021B under the separate petroleum program.

Hi Judy,

The subject ASTs were investigated and reports submitted to the RWQCB by the Navy. AST 021B was recommended for no further action and AST 540 was recommended for further action under the AST TPH program. They are among the 14 SWMUs located at IR Site 26 that need to be documented under the ROD. In DTSC review comment dated October 3, 2005 on the PP, Marcia Liao comments was "Navy to contact the WB for closure determination of ASTs 021B and AST 540". No further comments were provided by the agencies during the draft ROD review.

We would like to state in the draft final ROD on IR26 that, or something similar: a) no further action is needed for AST 021B, and b) any corrective actions on AST 540 will be deferred to the TPH program. This is consistent with the Navy "Request Deferral of Corrective Actions on SWMUs" letter of June 8, 2004 to the regulatory agencies.

Please let me know if more information is needed. Thanks.

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
