The U.S. Department of the Navy Announces Availability of the Record of Decision for Former Western Hangar Zone - Installation Restoration Site 26 Alameda Point, California



On July 31, 2006, the U.S. Department of the Navy (Navy) signed a record of decision (ROD) for Installation Restoration Site 26 at the former Naval Air Station Alameda (now referred to as "Alameda Point") in Alameda, California. The ROD was also signed by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the California Environmental Protection Agency Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC), and the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) on August 2, 3, and 7, 2006, respectively. The ROD documents the Navy's no further action decision for soil and remedial action decision for groundwater at Site 26.

Site 26 is located in the central portion of Alameda Point, which is adjacent to the City of Oakland, and occupies 1,734 acres of onshore land. The Navy used the site for aircraft parking, maneuvering, washdown, fueling, and maintenance as well as for painting and finishing operations. As a result of these activities, areas of groundwater were contaminated with volatile organic compounds (VOC). Based on data collected during thorough investigations of the site and assessments of potential human health and ecological risks, the selected remedial action for VOCs in groundwater at Site 26 is Alternative 6, which includes installation of monitoring wells and sampling, implementation of expedient and proven treatment strategies, and short-term land use and access restrictions at the site. The expected outcome of the selected remedial action is to restore the groundwater quality at Site 26 by reducing contaminant concentrations to levels that no longer pose a threat to human health. Remedial action, land use restrictions, and environmental monitoring are not required for Site 26 soil. These finding support the eventual transfer to and redevelopment of the property by the Alameda Reuse and Redevelopment Authority.
