Subj: SITE INVESTIGATION AT NAVAL AUXILIARY LANDING FIELD, CROWS LANDING FIRE FIGHTING SCHOOL

Enclosure (1) is the investigation report on the Naval Auxiliary Landing Field Crows Landing Fire Fighting School site which you requested during your telephone conversation with Kathy Nakazawa of this office on November 3, 1988. The report details the objectives of the sampling effort and summarizes the analytical results. A second report, further characterizing the lateral and vertical extent of contamination at the site, will be provided to you when available.

We have worked closely with the Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB), the lead agency for this site, on our investigations and proposed clean-up. Work plans and reports have been sent to the RWQCB for review and comment.

During our conversation you expressed concern regarding a monitoring well which was installed at the site. You had indicated that permits are required in your county for installing a monitoring well. In a subsequent conversation between you and our contractor, ERM-West, it was agreed that it would only be necessary to file for the permit presently, upon their receipt of the application. Section 121(e) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act provides that:

No federal, State, or local permit shall be required for the portion of any removal or remedial action conducted entirely on-site, where such remedial action is selected and carried out in compliance with this section.

Although the Navy is not required to obtain permits, we intend to satisfy any substantive requirements. Therefore, we will work closely with your department to provide you with information regarding work at Crows Landing. Enclosure (2) is your permit application form, providing substantive information. Additional reports will also be forwarded to you as they become available.
