Hello Jim,

My apologies for sending a blank message a moment ago. I acknowledge operator error.

For clarification on the previous submittal pertaining to wells at and near the Administration Area Plume at NASA Crows Landing Flight Facility, the following information is provided:

Final Irrigation Practices Technical Memorandum (PRC 1993) indicates that wells on privately-owned properties were not physically inspected; locations and uses of wells located on the Facility were verified (see page 8, paragraph 3.2).

During the summer and fall of 2000, the current Navy team conducted a reconnaissance for active and inactive water supply wells and monitoring wells on the Facility. I participated in the reconnaissance. We did not find additional water supply wells that were not documented in the PRC report except for the inactive well located within Building 151 at the Facility (this well was described in our well destruction permit application package in December 2000) and this well is located close to the current NASA water supply well.

The Navy did not request access agreements to inspect wells or to search for wells on privately-owned properties near the Facility during the reconnaissance of 2000.

I hope that this information is helpful.

We were actually requesting a sensitive receptor survey when we said physical survey. That involves a door-to-door, or walk-about survey within a 500-foot radius of the site, to look for undocumented wells.

Has the Navy conducted a physical survey? I could not find any reference to such an activity in this document.
