U. S. Navy Continues Extraction of
Contaminated Groundwater
at Administration Area Plume
at NASA Crows Landing Flight Facility

The Navy released an Action Memorandum describing time-critical removal actions for remediation of contaminated groundwater near former Underground Storage Tank (UST) Site 117 and near the carbon tetrachloride source area at the Administration Area Plume at NASA Crows Landing Flight Facility, California in August 2001. A public notice announcing the availability of the Action Memorandum for review was issued on 21 August 2001. The Action Memorandum was prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) and the removal actions include groundwater extraction and in situ treatment. The Navy began extracting contaminated groundwater from existing wells near UST Site 117 in the Administration Area Plume in September 2001. The Navy plans to continue groundwater extraction activities on an intermittent basis near UST Site 117 and at the carbon tetrachloride source area in order to remove contaminants until the final remedy is implemented. In situ treatment activities may be implemented concurrently with the groundwater extraction activities. The Navy invites the public to review and comment on the continued extraction activities. The Action Memorandum and other documents pertaining to the time-critical removal actions are available at the Stanislaus County Library, Patterson Branch on 46 North Salado, Patterson, California. The records for this action are available for review and comment at the library through 31 January 2002.
