Dear Ms. Olliges:

We are working with the Base Realignment and Closure Cleanup Team members in developing effective and efficient strategies for the management of the Installation Restoration Program (IRP) and Underground Storage Tank (UST) Program Sites at the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) Crows Landing Flight Facility. In order to accomplish our remediation, we are requesting assistance from your office in obtaining historical records and authorization to destroy two inactive water supply wells located on the facility property.

NASA constructed a water supply well within 500 feet of the southern edge of the Administration Area Plume (IRP Site 17) near Building 151 in February 1995. We understand that this well is used primarily for NASA's fire protection system. Due to the proximity of this well to the contaminant plume, we are requesting information pertaining to the well siting documentation, the pumping rates, the radius of influence, and the results of any aquifer tests that have been conducted at this well. We will utilize this information to evaluate possible remedial alternatives for the Administration Area Plume and to develop proposed groundwater use restrictions for the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) Record of Decision for IRP Site 17.

Prior to the construction of the NASA water supply well, two water supply wells located near Bell Road were utilized for the domestic water supply at the facility. The State of California, Health and Welfare Agency, Department of Health Services, Division of Drinking Water and Environmental Management document this in correspondence addressed to NASA of October 28, 1993 (encl. 1) and a Memorandum of October 27, 1993 (encl. 2). We are requesting historical information pertaining to the operation of the former domestic water supply system and to the management, laboratory testing, and destruction of the former water supply wells.


Additionally, we are requesting authorization from your office to destroy two inactive water supply wells that are located on the facility. Both wells are located in the vicinity of known groundwater contamination and prompt closure is recommended. One well is located within Building 151 and one well is located within a small pump house north of UST Cluster 2. Written authorization from NASA for the demolition of the pump house north of UST Cluster 2 is also requested in order to facilitate the videographic survey of the well and the destruction of the well.

We are also requesting an estimated schedule for the delivery of the historical and current facility plans and drawings that we discussed in last FY '01. The acquisition of these documents will facilitate the planning for future field sampling activities and response actions.
