Dear Mr. Anschutz:

I have reviewed the Naval Auxiliary Landing Field (NALF), Crowslanding, Underground Storage Tank (UST) Closure Investigation Report (Volumes 1 and 2). This report addresses the closure of USTs CL 1,2,3,7,8, and 9. I have also reviewed your letter dated April 29, 1991, which states that you have "negative test results for the leak detection conducted on these USTs and the associated piping". I will need to receive a copy of these test results.

Based on the results of the investigation, it may be possible to close tanks CL 7 and 8 by filling them in place. Items 1 - 3 must be completed before the filling in place of tanks CL-7 and 8 may be completed. For tanks CL 1,2,3 and 9 the type of closure will depend on the results of the future work. To continue with this closure process, the following items must be addressed:

1. At the time of tank closure all pipelines associated with tanks must be closed. It will be necessary to submit a proposal on how you intend to close all the piping associated with these tanks.
2. The Department of Navy must submit a proposal for the disposal of the water and sludge in tanks CL 7,8, and 9. Any on site disposal will require written approval from the Regional Water Control Board. A proposal for either the disposal or treatment of the contents of these tanks must be submitted in writing and approved by this department. The Health and Safety Code does not allow for a fill in place until all residual amounts of hazardous substances which was stored in the tank system prior to its closure have been removed, and/or properly disposed of.

3. Prior to final closure (fill in place) of tanks CL 1,2,3,7,8, and 9 at this site, the vertical and horizontal extent will have to be fully defined. I have referred the NALF Closure Investigation Report to Bob Fourt with our Site Mitigation Program for review and follow-up. He will arrange to meet with you regarding further soils and groundwater investigations.
