Dear Mr. Lau:

The Hazardous Materials Division has reviewed the January 30, 1995 Underground Storage Tank Report, prepared by PRC Environmental Management for the above contamination site. In August, 1994, underground storage tanks CL-102 (diesel fuel) and CL-138 (gasoline) were removed. Minor soil contamination was observed upon removal of CL-102, and in September, 1994, additional excavation was conducted at the CL-102 location to remove the contaminated soil. Soil samples collected from the base and sidewall excavation did not contain detectable contamination, indicating the contaminated soil had been excavated.

Minor soil contamination was observed during the removal of tank CL-138. The contaminated soil was excavated and soil samples were collected from the base of the excavation and near the fill pipe location. Gasoline range petroleum hydrocarbons (0.10 mg/kg TPH) were detected in the soil sample from the fill pipe location. The residual soil contamination near the former fill pipe does not pose a threat to groundwater quality. The excavated contaminated soil was stockpiled and treated on site.


Additional investigation or cleanup of soil contamination associated with former underground storage tanks CL-102 and CL-138 is not warranted at this time. The Underground Storage Tank Closure Permit (C94-36) for underground storage tanks

CL-102 and CL-138 will remain open since three other tanks (CL-7, CL-8, and CL-9) are included on the permit, and the investigation and cleanup associated with those tanks has not been completed.
