Subject: REQUEST FOR NO FURTHER ACTION CONCURRENCE FOR PETROLEUM
AT IRP SITE 12, NASA CROWS LANDING FLIGHT FACILITY, CROWS LANDING,
CALIFORNIA

The Navy requests your concurrence with no further action for petroleum at IRP Site 12. On October 8, 1999, the Board concurred with the no action alternative for IRP Site 12 in the *Final Record of Decision/Remedial Action Plan (ROD/RAP), Installation Restoration Program, Sites 10, 12, 13, 14, 16, and 18*. It is the Navy's understanding that the ROD/RAP concurrence includes no further action for petroleum, based on the data and analysis included in the RAP/ROD.

Two petroleum areas were discussed in the ROD/RAP. Underground Storage Tank (UST) CL-138 and associated piping were excavated and evaluated in the Remedial Investigation. The Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region concurred with no further action for UST CL-138 in their letter of September 28, 1998. The second tank area was discovered during demolition of the vehicle parts wash rack pad. During the demolition, a concrete ballast was encountered. This indicated a previously unknown UST had been removed. This second area has subsequently been referred to as UST CL-138A. To prevent any misinterpretation, the Navy requests the Board concur with NFA for petroleum and USTs CL-138 and CL-138A at IRP Site 12 based on the information in the ROD/RAP.
