The document adequately describes the groundwater sampling, geophysical surveying  
and exploratory trenching activities that will be conducted for Site 11B. However, there  
is no discussion of how investigation-derived hazardous waste will be handled if found  
during these activities. Therefore, please provide a narrative description of the  
contingency plan the Navy will implement if such wastes are encountered during the  
detailed field work.
