PUBLIC PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION MEETING
Proposed Plan - Sites 8, 11, and 12
4:30 - 7:30 p.m.

PURPOSE: The public is invited to participate at MCAS El Toro's public meeting to discuss and provide comments on the Proposed Plan for cleanup of contamination present in shallow soil at Installation Restoration Program Sites 8, 11, and 12. The public will have the opportunity to provide oral and written comments on the investigation results and the cleanup alternatives. Marine Corps representatives responsible for performing the investigation and presenting the results will be available to answer questions.

The Marine Corps' preferred remedy for the portions of the sites requiring remediation is excavation of approximately 25,000 cubic yards of contaminated soil from Sites 8, 11, and 12. The non-hazardous soil would be recycled as a foundation layer within two inactive landfills at Sites 2 and 17. The Marine Corps would dispose of any excavated hazardous soil at an appropriate off-Station disposal facility.
